

Public order act 27.6.2003/612 article 14:

Dog Discipline

In order to maintain public order and security the dog owner or operator shall:

- 1) keep the dog on the leash at densely populated area;
- 2) take care that unleashed dog doesn't get to exercise paths or any similar running track and doesn't get at all to public swimming beaches, areas that are reserved children play grounds, at market time to market squares or for public use maintained ski tracks or sport fields unless it is separately allowed;
- 3) take care that dog's faeces doesn't remain in the environment at managed areas in densely populated area.

What is decreed at subsection 1 point 1 and 2 **does not concern on** duty used state's owned dog, guard dog that is on guard duty, trained rescue dog that is on duty, disabled people's service dog or blind's guide dogs

What is decreed at subsection 1 point 1 does not concern closed yards, dog's training places or specified fenced-in walking area. Dog has to be supervised by owner or operator in these places also.

What is decreed at subsection 1 point 2 concerns also cats. What is enacted at subsection 1 point 1 and 2 concerns also horses and in suitable respects other domestic animals.
